Blessing of Fire and Lighting of the Candle		Presider
Processional:	RM 3rd Ed	“The Light of Christ”. – Procession moves from fire through breezeway and carpeted hallway. The Deacon chants (1) at the double doors, processes to middle of main and chants (2) (all light their candles from Paschal Candle) and process to sanctuary and chants (3) in front of the altar. All respond to each chant “Thanks be to God”.

Notes	Cantor; Instruments: piano, organ, guitar, cello, solo instrument
