

**Commemoration of the Lord's Entrance into Jerusalem  
(Lectionary #37B, Hymnal #919 – #922)**

<b>Preparatory Notes</b>	Set up in FC – 3 tables, palms, holy water, Presider's book Set up in church – two hand held microphones for reading the Gospel, 3 Gospel Reading Binders	
<b>Opening Antiphon (920)</b>	<b>[920] (pew)</b>	Opening Antiphon
<b>Blessing of Branches Gospel B (921)</b>	Mark 11:1-10 or John 12:12-16 – Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.	
<b>First Form: The Procession (922)</b>	<b>425</b>	Hosanna
<b>Notes</b>	The Procession will leave the FC, proceed through the breezeway, through the front parking lot, and through the Winton Road doors of the Church. There needs to be three cantors in the procession: one at the beginning, middle and end respectively. The cantor at the beginning starts the singing for the procession. The rest of the musicians leave the FC first and take their places via the sacristy.
